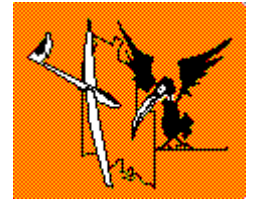

- Registration** Please present GFA Membership Card (both pilots) and the aircraft's current Maintenance Release at Registration.

- Radio** Aircraft must be fitted with a radio with 122.5, 122.7 and 122.9 Mhz frequencies (CTAF frequency is 126.7 – highly recommended but not mandatory). It is strongly recommended that gliders be insured for 3rd party and public liability.
- Parachutes** Parachutes are mandatory in all classes.
- Entry Fee** Entry fee is per aircraft independent of the number of pilots.
- Entry forms and payment must be received by Friday 16th November 2001. A late fee of \$20 will apply for entries received after this date.
- Rules** A copy of the Competition Rules are available on the web page

- A hard copy will be sent if specifically requested in writing. These rules are intended as a guideline – the organisation reserves the right to alter the rules before the start of the contest. Final versions of the rules and local rules will be at registration
- Experience** Pilots must hold a minimum of Silver Badge, be in current practice and be current on aerotow.
- Verification** Data logger or GPS track logs are accepted. It is the pilot's responsibility to provide necessary software and cables for downloading and verifying of the logger data.
- Accommodation** Waikerie Gliding Club can only accommodate 50 people on the airfield. Please book early by phoning the Waikerie Office 8541 2644.
- Meals** Breakfasts, cut lunches and full cooked evening meals will be available at the clubhouse at moderate charges. The clubhouse is well equipped and has a licenced bar. A separate kitchen (including fridge facilities) is available for use by pilots.
