5. MEMBERSHIP FEES

The WGC Membership year is 1 July to 30 June. Rates are inclusive of GST.

*Temporary WGC membership of \$75 is available for visiting and international pilots who wish to operate from WGC but will have no access to club gliders and no voting rights. Membership lasts for a maximum of 3 months and pilots must be members of GFA.

** Associate membership (non-flying) is available for anyone wishing to be involved with WGC (e.g. partners, family members) but will have no voting rights.

All WGC glider pilots are required to be, and are responsible to ensure they are, current financial members of both WGC and GFA. GFA membership is optional for all non-flying members and GFA membership includes SAGA membership.

6. FLYING CHARGES

6.1 Glider Hire

To fly a WGC-owned or cross-hired glider as pilot-in-command, a pilot must be a current financial member of both WGC and GFA. Rates are inclusive of GST.

The maximum glider charge per flight in peak season (1 Oct to 31 Mar) is 4 hours.

The maximum glider charge per flight in off-peak season (1 Apr to 30 Sep) is 2 hours.

Members are liable for damage to Club-owned and cross-hired gliders and trailers, however this may be limited. In-house insurance to waive the liability is available. See the Self-insurance Regulation for details.

6.2 Tug Hire

Tug launch times are stop-watch recorded by the time-keeper or tug pilot and ferry/retrieve times are taken from the Hobbs hour meter in the tug. Charges are for recreational flying and are per minute or part thereof and are inclusive of GST.

Dry-hire rate to other clubs \$5.50/min.

Consideration of an aero-tow retrieve will be given providing no significant disruption occurs to on-field operations and there is no total fire ban in force.

Only appropriately experienced and rated pilots will be retrieved from paddocks deemed suitable by the tug pilot.

The pilot who calls for the aero-tow retrieve is responsible for the tug costs, regardless of whether or not the retrieve is completed.

6.3 Air Experience Flights

Basic Flight \$175 plus \$1/min over 20 minutes

Aerobatic Flight \$200 plus \$1/min over 15 minutes

7. ACCOMMODATION CHARGES

All charges are inclusive of GST. Facilities and accommodation are also available for hire by arrangement to non-members. Please contact billmudge@bigpond.com

Members and guests are expected to be considerate of others and keep noise to a minimum after 2200 hrs.

Sleeping in the clubhouse is not permitted.

Members are expected to keep their accommodation area or site clean and tidy, particularly when vacating.

Lost keys will incur a \$20 fee.

Pets are not allowed inside Club accommodation or clubrooms.

Rates include use of members' kitchen for all gliding visitors, members or non-members.

Additional \$5 per day charge applies to non-gliding visitors using members' kitchen.

NOTE: Members who stay in dormitory accommodation (this only applies to the three dormitory rooms, and the member must provide their own linen) for the sole purpose of working on the Club's behalf (e.g. Committee meetings, working bees, instructing, towing, annual inspections, running competitions or courses) will have free accommodation and need not enter the stay on

the Member Charge Sheet in the office. Members who stay for personal reasons (e.g. intending to or actually flying a glider, holidaying, travel stop-over, working on private aircraft, or whatever) will be charged (and need to fill in the Members Charge Sheet in the office) if they stay the night before and/or the night after.

All Club bed accommodation is non-smoking.

Mattresses and pillows must be covered when in use.

Club linen is available if required in the non-member rate.

Members must provide their own linen or else non-member rates will apply.

Limited hangar space is sometimes available for private gliders on a temporary or annual basis. Dormitory accommodation or facilities use is available to members on an annual basis in lieu of the daily charge.

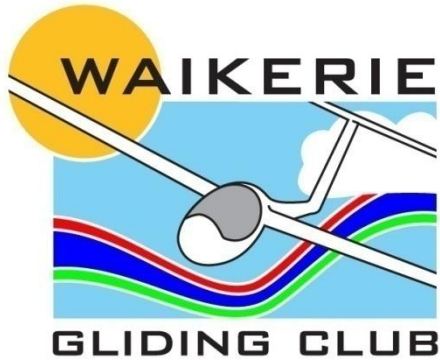
